The safety course was introduced to assist employers in transitioning to new requirements in the amended Occupational Health and Safety Act, requiring employers to provide the same workplace safety training for unpaid workers as they would for employers. The intent was to provide basic training to assist those employers who might not be aware of the changes or have the resources in place to provide the training.

Many schools in the college have already opted out of this training, finding it redundant to training provided by employers. The same holds true for the School of Contemporary Media.

The training is not legally required by Fanshawe, and is not tied to any learning outcomes or essential employability skills for any of our programs. Going forward, we will advise employers of their obligation to provide this training for students on placement, and that we do not provide any training of our own.
