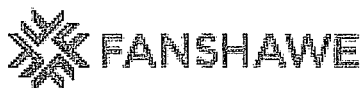
Hi Sandy – thanks, this is great.
Are you ok with a minor tweak as below:

Doula's are independent practitioners who accompany women at birth. The women who ask for doulas at childbirth may be from vulnerable populations, incarcerated women, woman living in poverty, women with mental health issues, and any other women wishing to have a doula present. The doula graduate needs to have a sound knowledge base, and be capable of dealing with the childbearing risks for the woman and newborn, as well as the potential increased safety risks for vulnerable populations.

A 60% grade is required as the minimum passing grade for the Doula program. The nature of the skill set required for successful graduates of the program involves life/death scenarios justifying the need for a higher passing grade.
