Hi Sandra:

In double-checking the 2014/2015 degree audits today, I realized that the changes for PFT1 Levels 1 and 2 were not incorporated into PSI1 Levels 1 and 2. (as you know the first year of PSI is common with PFT).

The degree audit changes for PSI1 (to match PFT1) should be:

- 1) Move PFLP-1004, Criminal Code, from Level 1 to Level 2
- 2) Move PFLP-1001, Career Opportunities from Level 2 to Level 1
- 3) In level 2, replace PFLP-1015, Ethics **45 hours**, with PFLP-1019, Ethics **30 hours**
