To facilitate the online activity occurring in 20F, the program is moving many theory courses from level 6 to level 5. The courses to be moved are DENT 5025, Evidence Based Practice; DENT 5024 Professional Practice 4; and DENT 5023 Dental Hygiene Practice Management.

In addition when this level moves to level 6 in 21W we are proposing to combine DENT 5020 and DENT 5022 (Community Health Practice 2&3). The new course code is DENT 5031.

The program hours remain the same but with the combination of DENT 5020 and DENT 5022 the credits are reduced by 3.25 (calculation in Appendix A).
