#### Applied Degree Factor

Please note that the funding parameters assigned above, include an applied degree factor of 0.025. The ministry will monitor and review the relative costs of applied degree programs to ascertain whether this factor is appropriate to reflect the relative additional ongoing costs of delivery.

### **Tuition Fees**

Applied degree programs are considered as post-diploma programs for the purpose of charging additional cost recovery tuition fees, i.e. the enrolment in applied degree programs is considered to be outside of the 15% maximum.

### **Tuition Set Aside**

No tuition set aside will be required for applied degree programs during the first year the program is offered. In the second year of the program, colleges will be required to set aside 30% of the year-over-year tuition fee increase.

### **Capital Expenditures**

As with any other newly-approved program, funding of capital beyond current commitments will not be available to colleges offering applied degree programs.
