The Ministry of Education and Training has assessed your proposal, dated November 27, 1998, to revise your existing Hotel and Restaurant Management program by changing the title to Hotel Management. Please accept this as approval of the title revision effective September, 1999. Please also note that this program remains subject to the program standard for Hospitality Management - Hotel and Restaurant Management.

Your proposal also requested a modification in approved duration from three academic semesters to four. The ministry, however, originally approved this program as a four-semester offering, subsequently maintaining the two-year approval and funding levels consistent with all other programs in MCU category 53200. To the extent that the college merely restructured the program's format a number of years ago, running a four-semester equivalent program in compressed mode without affecting the learning outcomes of the program or individual student course loads, a formal amendment of program duration is not required in the circumstances.
